

MISSION TO MALINES, BELGIUM

April 19, 1944.

"This target is located on the main Zeebrugge-Ghent-Hasselt German railroad line. It is important as an alternate channel to the German rail route. It includes first class locomotive repair shops, and is one of the two main rolling stock repair centers in Belgium."

--Intelligence Annex to 99th Bomb Wing Field Order 15-272.

After a full week's operational inactivity due to bad weather, the route out took 39 of the Group's planes on a course over North Foreland to Furnes to Wasreghem to Termonde to the target, where one hundred fifty-two 1000 pound General Purpose bombs were dropped with good results. Ninth Bomber Command's Summary of Operations for the day listed first phase interpretation of the Group's work as I blows:


"One hundred percent of bombs in the target area. Hits observed in yards and on repair sheds."

Meager inaccurate flak was experienced at the target and from the Northeast corner of Walcheren Island. Light tracer flak was also directed at the formation from a barge off the tip of Schouwen Island. Only one aircraft received minor battle damage, however, and there were no casual



Last known photo of Spitfire MJ558 at RAF Hornchurch 1944.


